**Overnight camping available Friday, 9/26-9/28. Day parking and Camping will be at Ranger Creek and **not the horse camp**. You will need a Northwest Forest Pass (Day pass can be purchased at the location or an annual pass at a US Forestry office) and Weed Free hay**

**No potable water! Vault toilets at camp may not be available due to current state!**

**Directions: From Enumclaw, travel east on State Highway 410 about 29 miles to Forest Service road 7160. Near mile marker 54. Turn right at Ranger Creek/Buck Creek sign. Turn left at the main entrance to Ranger Creek Campground/Airstrip. There will be C.M.O. plate pointing to the correct road to take.**
